

FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR POSTGRADUATE TAUGHT PROGRAMMES (MSc) IN SOCIAL STATISTICS AND DEMOGRAPHY

Candidates for the MSc programmes in Social Statistics and Demography can apply for or be nominated for MSc and MSc+PhD scholarships. These scholarships include:

- ESRC-DTC (Doctoral Training Centre) studentships (up to 6 available): A portion of these studentships will be available as part of a 1+3 programme, whereby student complete a 1-year MSc in Demography or Social Statistics followed by a 3-year PhD. These studentships pay £13,863 per year tax free (2014-2015 rates), include additional funds for Research Training and Overseas Fieldwork, plus the chance to apply for an extra £3,000 per year for training in advanced quantitative methods during your PhD. Your fees are also covered.
- **Social Sciences Masters Scholarships**: we are delighted to be offering several one-year MSc scholarships for our MSc programmes in Demography or Social Statistics for the 2015 academic year. These will be available for International and Home/EU students, and will provide a substantial discount towards the cost of your fees.
- **Population Investigation Committee (PIC) scholarships**: in recent years, the PIC has offered one-year scholarships for students undertaking an MSc with high demographic content. We expect the scheme to run again this year, and we anticipate putting forward up to 3 top candidates. We are usually successful in obtaining these scholarships for at least one student per year, worth £15,000.
