## Protecting your Tier 4 visa. Top tips

## Protecting your Tier 4 visa is important, both for completing your studies and for avoiding potential problems with any future immigration applications you may need to make. Here are some top tips:

- Attendance: you are required to be studying full-time if you are in the UK on a Tier 4 visa. If you need to miss any classes, or if you need to leave the UK during term-time, please discuss this with your faculty as soon as possible. The University also monitors your attendance through access to our electronic systems.
- Keeping your documents safe: you should keep your passport and visa safe at all times, both in the UK and

- when travelling don't carry them with you if you don't need to. You should also keep copies of these documents in case you lose them.
- Updating your records: you
  must make sure that the University,
  the Home Office, and the police (if
  required) hold up-to-date contact
  details for you at all times. You should
  also make sure that the VISAS Team
  always have a copy of your most recent
  passport and visa.
- Employment: don't work more than your permitted hours – it is a criminal offence, and may prevent you from completing your course. Your work restrictions will be printed on your visa.
- Extending your visa: VISAS can help you with your application, so don't apply by yourself. If you think you need to extend your visa, get in touch with us as soon as possible – don't leave it to the last minute.
