#### **Summer Schools**

There are a number of overseas Summer Schools that we promote on behalf of our partners and we have a special Summer School section on our website where you can see what opportunities are available.

Summer school programmes give students the chance to complete a shorter period of study abroad, normally four weeks over the summer break. Some of these programmes entitle University of Southampton students to a full or partial fee waiver as part of our international agreements.

Please note that these do not carry any transferable credit but do offer an important International experience within your degree if a semester or year abroad is not a viable option for you. If you participate in one of the opportunities listed on our website you will also be eligible for our £500 Southampton Opportunity Scholarship.



## FEES, FUNDING AND SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDY AND WORK ABROAD

#### **Student Finance**

Regardless of whether you are studying or working abroad as part of your degree, you are still entitled to support from Student Finance. This includes both your tuition fee loan and maintenance grant. Additional support is also available for students who qualify for means-tested loans.

#### **Tuition Fees**

When you participate in an exchange programme, no fees are paid to the partner institution but you will still have to pay some fees to the University of Southampton. The amount you are charged is based on the time you spend studying abroad. Please see our Fees and Funding page for more information.

## **Erasmus Student Mobility Grant**

Whilst we are still part of the Erasmus+ programme students studying at one of our European partners or working in Europe as part of their degree can benefit from an EU-funded mobility grant. This grant is based on the number of weeks spent studying or working abroad and is supplementary to any maintenance loans. Extra financial support is available from the Erasmus scheme for students from low income households or students with disabilities.

## Southampton Opportunity Scholarship

A scholarship of at least £500 will be available to every student participating in a non-Erasmus exchange programme as part of their degree. This also includes participation in an overseas Summer School Experience.

## External Scholarships

There are other scholarships external to the University which students may be eligible to apply for. We regularly update this information on our website and include it in pre-departure support.

## SUPPORT BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER YOUR TIME ABROAD

## Exchange Coordinators and the International Office

Each Academic Unit has its own dedicated Exchange Coordinator who supports students throughout their exchange. This includes advising students on partner universities, supporting them through the application process and helping them choose their modules. In addition to the academic member of staff, each Academic Unit has an exchange administrator in the student office to advise on practical administrative matters.

The teams in each Academic Unit are supported by the Study Abroad and Exchange Team in the International Office. This central team supports all exchange and study abroad activity across the University including advising students, giving predeparture support and working with students upon their return.

## **Support for Disabled Students**

Students with disabilities are able to access additional support through Enabling Services. Students are encouraged to discuss their needs with Enabling Services as soon as possible before their period of study or work abroad. www.southampton.ac.uk/edusupport/

#### **Accommodation - Home and Away**

The University of Southampton invites students returning from a semester or year abroad to apply for halls of residence. Whilst accommodation cannot be guaranteed, best endeavours will be used to try and accommodate returning students. www.southampton.ac.uk/accommodation/

For those students who wish to organise private rented accommodation, support with housing

contracts is accessible through SUSU. The accommodation service is also able to give advice. www.susu.org/help-and-support

Whilst students are on exchange, accommodation options are based on what the partner institution is able to offer. Some partners can offer accommodation in University residences, whilst others may not and students will have to look for private rented accommodation when they arrive. Students are advised to look at the partner institution's accommodation arrangements as part of their preliminary research into their study abroad options.

#### Insurance

The University of Southampton will be able to provide comprehensive travel insurance to all students undertaking an approved placement overseas at no extra cost. However if you are travelling to USA, Canada or Australia there will be additional cover that you will need to purchase at your own cost. Please contact us for more details on how to apply.

### **Language Opportunity**

Whilst many of our exchange partners teach in English, should you wish to learn another language to assist you in your exchange the Southampton Language Opportunity provides you with the opportunity to study a language free of charge, alongside your degree programme. The scheme is funded by the Southampton Opportunity and managed by Modern Languages. For more information email
