

International applicants selection process

MSc Audiology and MSc Audiology (with clinical placement)

2018-19 applicants

You submit your initial application for the one-year MSc Audiology programme (even if you are interested in the two-year programme). The application deadline for 2018/19 entry onto the two-year MSc Audiology (with clinical placement) is **27th April 2018**. If applicable, **please indicate your wish to be considered for a placement in your personal statement**. The application deadline for the one-year MSc Audiology programme is **31st July 2018**.

We receive your initial application and it is acceptable.

We send you two short assignments to complete. If you have included a placement request we will also ask you to complete a 200 word statement explaining why you should be accepted onto a placement. If your first assignment submission is not adequate you will be provided with feedback and the opportunity to re-submit.

If you **PASS** the two assignments but do not provide an adequate placement statement we will give you an offer to study the **one-year MSc Audiology programme** with us.

If you **PASS** the two assignments and provide an adequate placement statement we will contact you in **May 2018** to provide your placement location options. You must reply to us with your placement preferences **within 2 weeks** of us contacting you. Following this we will organise for your potential placement provider to interview you (this can be carried out over the phone).

If you **FAIL** the assignments you will **not be made an offer** to come and study with us.

If you pass the interview with your potential placement provider you will be made an offer to study the **two-year MSc Audiology (with clinical placement) programme** with us. We will confirm your placement location with you by **31st July 2018**.

If you do not pass the interview you will be made an offer to study the **one-year MSc Audiology programme** with us.
