

# Full-Time MBA programme 2017/18 - Scholarship Factsheet

Tuition fee:

£23,500

(includes study trip, IPad with all core textbooks preloaded, any teaching off campus, AMBA and CMI membership and subscription to Financial Times and QS Workplace)

## **Global Scholarships**

Global I	25% tuition fee-related discount (£5,875)
Global II	15% tuition fee-related discount (£3,525)

These are automatic scholarships based upon your academic grade and level of work experience.. You do not need to do anything to receive this scholarship as it will be awarded automatically if you receive an offer of a place.

#### **Competitive Scholarships**

In addition you may receive one of the following scholarships, either as a stand-alone or a top-up the Global Scholarships:

Business Excellence	10% tuition fee-related discount (£2,350)
Regional Ambassador	10% tuition fee-related discount (£2,350)
(South Asia, Africa and Latin	
America, including Mexico and	
Caribbean)	

These scholarships will be awarded from 1 April, 2017 onwards by the MBA Director, based on your application. In order to have the best chance of being selected you should therefore apply to the MBA as early as possible, i.e. before March. All applicants shortlisted for the competitive scholarships will be interviewed.

## Alumni Benefits

For University of Southampton alumni a further 10% discount will be made to the fees after all scholarships are applied.

For further information see some examples of how our scholarships work below:

## Example 1

An applicant with the equivalent of a 2.1 and 6 years' work experience who is accepted will automatically receive the Global I scholarship, and will therefore pay  $\pm 17,625$  ( $\pm 23,500 - \pm 5,875 = \pm 17,625$ ).

However, they may also attract a Business Excellence or Regional Ambassador scholarship, which means they will receive a further  $\pounds$ 2,350 and therefore pay  $\pounds$ 15,275 ( $\pounds$ 23,500 -  $\pounds$ 5,875- $\pounds$ 2,350 =  $\pounds$ 15,275).

## Example 2

An applicant with the equivalent of a 2.1 and 4 years work experience who is accepted will automatically receive the Global II scholarship, and will therefore pay  $\pm 19,975$  ( $\pm 23,500 - \pm 3,525 = \pm 19,975$ ).

However, they may also attract a Business Excellence or Regional Ambassador scholarship, which means they will receive a further  $\pounds$ 2,350 and pay  $\pounds$ 17,625 ( $\pounds$ 23,500 -  $\pounds$ 3,525 -  $\pounds$ 2,350 =  $\pounds$ 17,625).

#### Example 3

An alumnus of the University of Southampton with a 2.1 and 6 years work experience who applies to the MBA would automatically attract a Global I scholarship. In addition, they could win a Business Excellence or Regional Ambassador scholarship (just as in Example 1), but with the additional alumni discount of 10% they would actually pay  $\pm 13,748$  (( $\pm 23,500 \pm 5,875 \pm 2,350$ )\*0.9= $\pm 13,748$ ).
