About the University of Southampton

PhD study opportunities

Standard PhD programmes involve three years of full time independent research. Some academic areas offer 4 year integrated PhD programmes (iPhD) which may involve taught modules as well as independent research. We offer a wide range of courses at undergraduate and postgraduate levels, including Engineering, Science, Health and Life Sciences, Law, Management, Medicine, Education, Humanities and Social Sciences.

2019 Scholarships – Terms and Conditions

Funding

Several scholarships will be available for 2019 entry. The scholarships cover full tuition fee costs for each year of the PhD programme for 3 or 4 years, depending on the length of the programme.

To be eligible for this scholarship, candidates must also successfully apply for a scholarship for living costs from the Chinese Scholarship Council (CSC) or funding from another source (minimum value of USD 1,500 per month).

Entry requirements

Each PhD programme has particular academic entry requirements and English language requirements.

- Academic entry requirements Typical academic entry requirements are a Bachelor degree with a minimum final grade of 80%.
- English language requirements These range from IELTS 6.0 to IELTS 7.0 overall, with particular grades required in each component. Applicants must have met the English language requirements when they apply for the scholarship.

The application process

Candidates need to:

- Identify a suitable PhD programme: www.southampton.ac.uk/courses/research-postgraduate.page
- Contact the Faculty PhD Admissions team to discuss a suitable project and/or potential supervisor for the research topic, and any deadline for applications.
- Make a PhD application to the University of Southampton using the online postgraduate application form, including appropriate documents and a research proposal if required.

 - o Allow sufficient time for the Admissions team to process the application and make a decision.
 - To be nominated, candidates must **either** have received an offer of a PhD place **or** have firm confirmation of support from a potential supervisor and made an application.
- Apply to the Talent Service Office at Xiamen University. Only applicants who are selected and nominated by the Talent Office will be eligible.

The University of Southampton will review all the nominations and will select final candidates. Xiamen University will nominate suitable candidates for CSC scholarships. Scholarships will be confirmed once successful candidates can demonstrate they have secured funding for their living costs from the CSC or other funding organisation.
