 Patients, carers and the public can be involved at every stage

Identify topics for research

Identification and Prioritisation

Clarify the research question

Design

Ensure methods are ethical and suitable

Advise on Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI)

Grant application

Define outcome measures

Be part of project steering or research advisory groups

Recruitment and Data Collection

Help write study protocols/participant information sheets/ consent forms

Identify recruitment barriers

Analysis and Interpretation

Inform researchers on how to interpret the data and identify themes

Reflect on process of being involved, PPI impact, and use learnings to guide future work

Evaluation

Has this research made a difference? How and why?

Implementation

Develop patient information for new services/treatments

Dissemination

Help reach new audiences

Jointly present findings and co-author papers

Knowledge mobilisation should be considered throughout the whole research process
