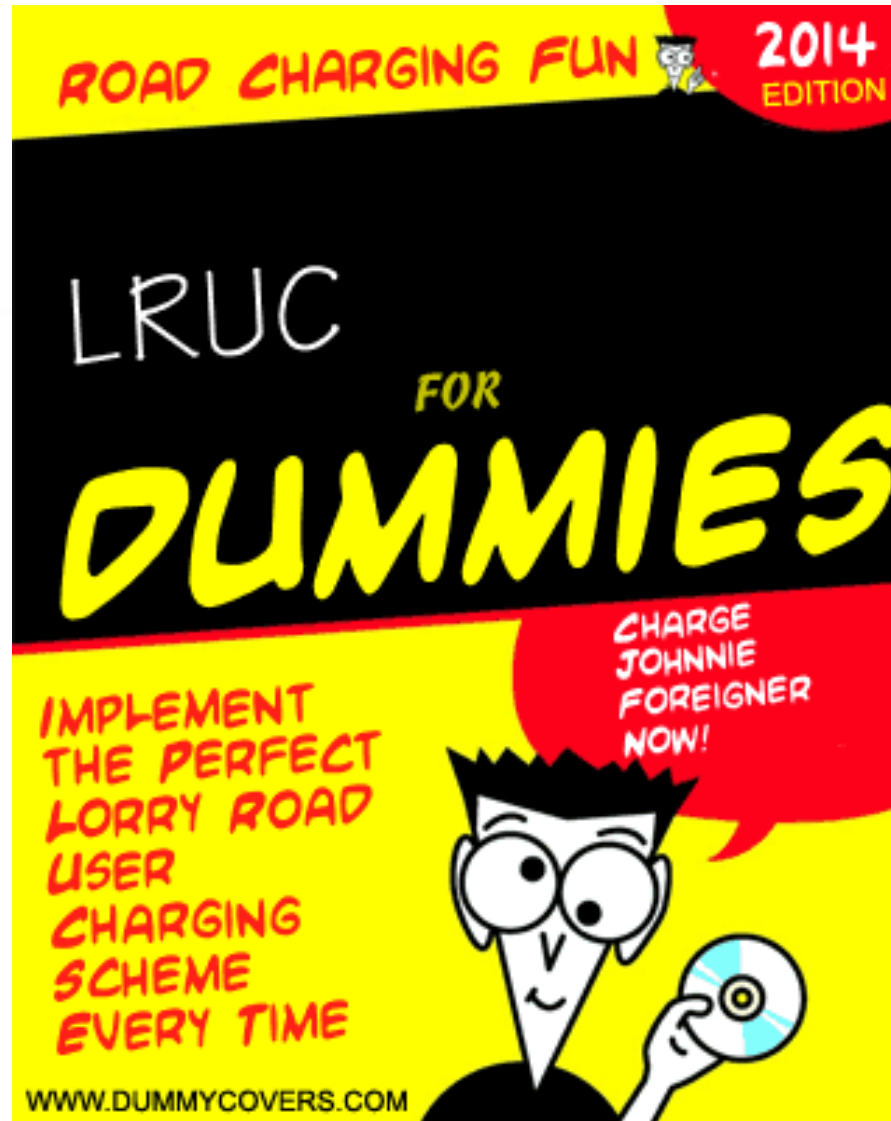

## ITS In Road User Charging: Case Studies

Road User Charging is widely used within Europe:

- Distance based: Lorry Road User Charging: Austria, Czech Republic, Germany, Poland, Slovakia, Switzerland.
  - Enables new investment in roads infrastructure
  - Encourages use of cleaner vehicles
  - Reduces empty journeys
- Motorway Charging for Private Vehicles:
  - Austria, France, Germany, Hungary, Czech Republic...



## Road User Charging Works

- Austrian LKW Maut raises revenues of >€2 million per day, infrastructure investment was repaid by Q3 of first year of operation
- Czech Republic Scheme raised €325 million in 2011
- The HGV Charge in the UK may raise £ 28 million if it's lucky.



## Other Live Uses of ITS in Road User „Charging“

- Congestion Charging – London, Stockholm
- Low emission zones - London
- Access Projects – Historic City Centres in Italy
- Pay-as-you-drive „black box“ insurance
