Why Jiangxi?

Jiangxi, a southeast Chinese province, centred in the Gan River valley, is defined by its pastoral landscapes of rice paddies, rivers and mountains. The mountainous terrain and large forest coverage of Jiangxi has made it historically one of the more wild places of central China. Nanchang is the capital city of Jiangxi and is located in the north-central part of the province. It is bounded on the west by the Jiuling Mountains, and on the east by Poyang Lake. As a result of its strategic location connecting the prosperous East and South China, Nanchang has become a major railway hub in Southern China in recent decades. Jiangxi University of Finance and Economics (JUFEE), founded in 1923, is located in Nanchang city.

Costing

The cost of this exciting trip is 1500RMB (approx £175). This includes accommodation, tuition, trips and meals. Airfare and visa arrangement costs will be in addition to this. Please bring spending money for your own use.
