He studied violin with Michael McLellan and piano with Jodi Szu Ying Chen. In 2006 he completed his grade 7 violin and piano with the ABRSM and grade 6 in theory. In 2008 he studied piano performance at Assumption University of Thailand with Paulo Zereu. During his time here he participated in various masterclasses and gave many recital as a soloist and accompanist. He graduated with a GPA of 3.82 out of 4.00. In 2012 he started his Master of Music degree in piano performance at the University of Southampton, studying with David Owen Norris and Veronika Illinskaya.
