MS 225 Archives of the *Jewish Chronicle*, 1841-1990

The purpose of this catalogue is not to recount the history of the *Jewish Chronicle*, which has been the subject of two longer publications, marking its centenary and sesquicentenary, besides other scholarly works.¹ Rather it is to describe the surviving archive of the newspaper. This task is much more circumscribed: although the newspaper itself survives as a source of the first importance for the history of Anglo-Jewry over the last one hundred and fifty years, its archives are confined, sadly, almost exclusively to the period after World War II. They were in large part lost in an air raid on 29 December 1940 which destroyed the offices of the newspaper in London, in Moor Lane, and most of the material at Southampton is consequently of post-war date.

The archive falls into four principal groups. Company records for *Jewish Chronicle* group companies form the first section. In addition there are central administrative files covering a range of subjects from buildings, to the *Jewish Chronicle* Association Football Trophy competition, literary awards, readership and circulation, staff and syndication. A second group contains the papers of D.F.Kessler, for many years managing director of the *Jewish Chronicle*. It includes Mr Kessler's papers relating to associated companies, particularly the activities of two publishing ventures, *Jewish Chronicle* Publications and Vallentine, Mitchell Ltd. Mr Kessler's papers also contain material relating to organisations with which he was closely associated, for example the Minority Rights Group, the Religious Weekly Press Group, the Paladin Club, the Parkes-Wiener Association and the Wiener Library. Here, as elsewhere in the archive, the papers are not easily divided between *Jewish Chronicle* activities and other interests, as it was common for individuals to work on a range of projects. Thirdly, the archive contains a further small group of papers of other directors of the *Jewish Chronicle*.

The fourth and largest group of correspondence in the archive is the editorial correspondence of J.M.Shaftesley, W.Frankel and G.D.Paul, successively occupant of the editor's chair, from 1946 to 1990. The editors' files were originally arranged in two sequences, an annual, alphabetical sequence, and a further group covering subjects, organisations and regular correspondents. Parts of this arrangement remain. The alphabetical sequence (each year was once split into two six-monthly sequences) survives for J.M.Shaftesley in part for 1951, 1953 and 1954; and more substantially for 1955-8. Less has survived in sequence for the early years of William Frankel's editorship, for 1959, 1961 and 1963; but there is much more in the files from 1964-5 onwards, except for the years 1971-2. Some work on sorting and weeding the papers was carried out prior to the transfer of the archive to Southampton in 1993, particularly on the files of W.Frankel and D.Kessler, and some of this material was regrouped by correspondent.

The first issue of *Jewish Chronicle* newspaper appeared in October 1841, a month after another journal in the field, the *Voice of Jacob*, produced by Jacob Abraham Franklin (1809-77). The two publications had different standpoints, but it was clear by the mid-1840s that there was insufficient market in Anglo-Jewry to support two newspapers and the publications subsequently merged. The *Jewish Chronicle* archive contains a small group of letters addressed to Franklin, editor of the *Voice of Jacob*, 1841-6.² Two other collections at Southampton contain holdings substantially related to the *Jewish Chronicle* archive. Papers of I.M.Greenberg, editor of the newspaper from 1936 until 1946, covering the years 1935-49, now form MS 150; and further papers of J.M.Shaftesley, for 1950-78, constitute MS 230.
