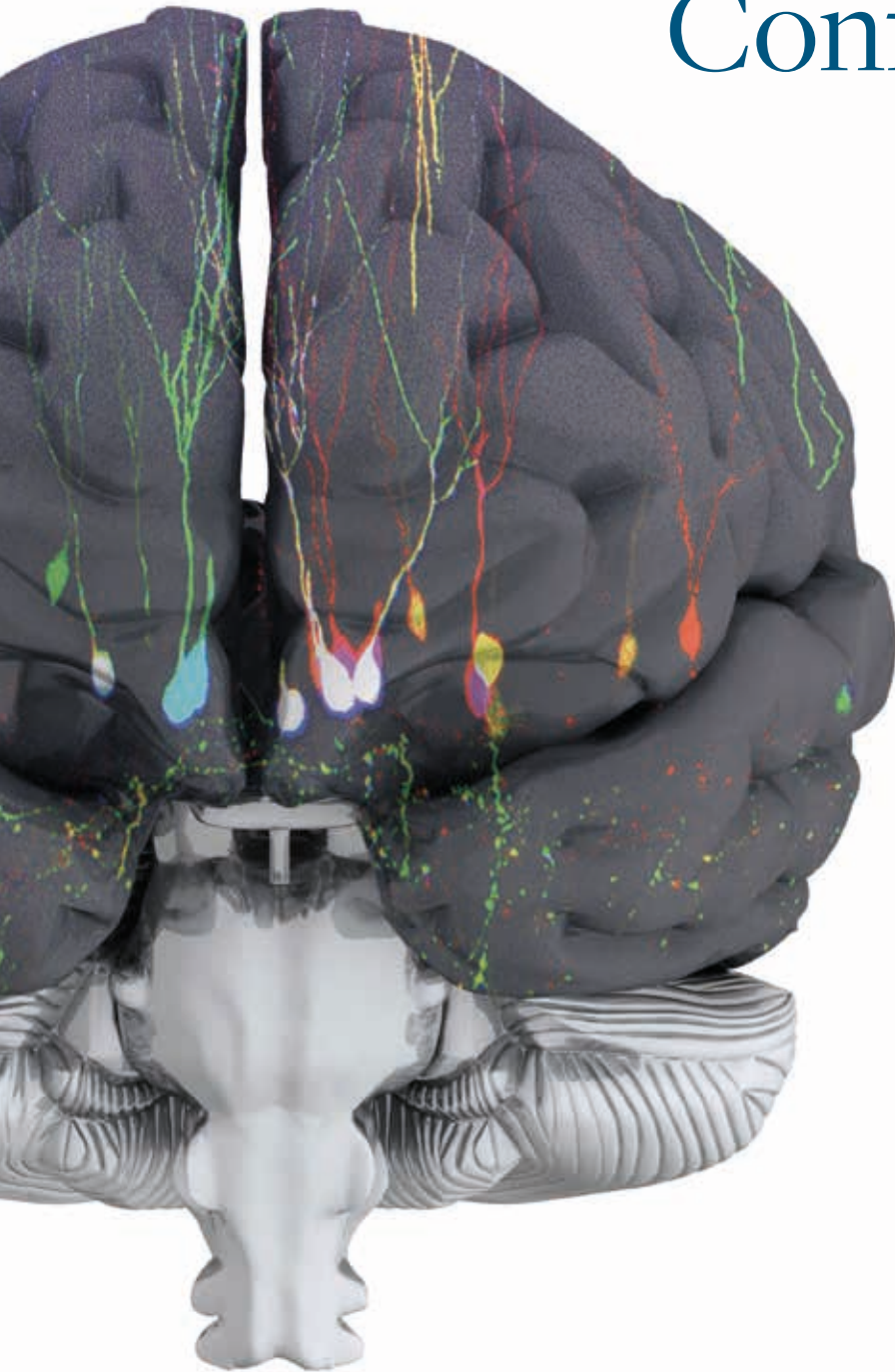


‘Dementia’. Institute for Life Sciences Conference
