

- 1. The Be Active Run Club competition is open to all University of Southampton students.
- 2. The Be Active Run Club competition is free to enter, and no purchase is necessary. All members of the Be Active Run Club will automatically become part of this competition, all participants must be current students at the University of Southampton.
- 3. University of Southampton students will be asked to join the Strava platform to automatically record their runs, all participants must be members of the Be Active Run Club to officially participate. All students must abide by the Be Active Run Clubs rules which are included on the specific club page, all students are participating at their own risk. Each participant will receive a point per run and be able to achieve further points for their pace.

Points Criteria	Points Given
Per Run	1 point (more than 1 point per day will not be given*)
Average Pace	5 points for the weekly average fastest pace
	4 points for the weekly 2 <sup>nd</sup> fastest average pace
	3 points for the weekly 3 <sup>rd</sup> fastest average pace
	2 points for the weekly 4 <sup>th</sup> fastest average pace
	1 points for the weekly 5 <sup>th</sup> fastest average pace
	(No points will be given after the 5 <sup>th</sup> fastest)

4. All entries/runs will be collated every Monday morning, with the necessary points given:

- 5. \*Each contestant will only be entered once per day, if the participant choices to complete more than one run per day only the first run of the day will be included in this competition.
- 6. Each participant must run for at least a distance of 2KM, anything under this distance will not be entered.
- 7. It is the responsibility of each student to ensure they are fit and healthy to participate, we recommend speaking to your doctor for advice on whether you are unsure about exercising.

- 8. Images used on Strava: The student further warrants and represents that the photograph is not explicit, offensive, or in breach of any applicable legislation or regulations.
- 9. The opening date for entries is 07:00am GMT on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2021 The closing date of the prize draw is 22:00pm GMT on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021. Entries received after this time will not be considered but might be used within future marketing campaigns. *Sport & Wellbeing/Be Active have the right to close this competition early at anytime.*
- 10. If for any reason a technical interruption, fault or Strava platform failure occurs when entering online, the University does not take any responsibility for incomplete entries and any incomplete entries will not be considered valid for entry into the prize draw. The University accepts no responsibility for any entries which are not completed for any reason.
- 11. The winners will be announced by the Be Active team via their facebook page (<u>www.facebook.com/beactiveuos</u>), this will also be announced on the official Strava page. Each prize winner will be contacted via their student email address to arrange collection or drop off their prize.



12. The current point and prize systems works as followed:

All prizes are subject to change, and all participants should note that some prizes might be amended with a specific other prize or Sport & Wellbeing offering. All prizes that are amended will be around the same price bracket of the original prize advertised.



- 13. As mentioned winners will be contacted via their student email address, each week the points leader board will be published to <u>www.facebook.com/beactiveuos</u> and the Strava Run Club group. If you wish to be excluded from this then please let us know by emailing <u>sportandwellbeing@southampton.ac.uk</u>, it is important to note that surnames will never be used when this is published.
- 14. For the purposes of the Data Protection Act 1988 the data controller is the University of Southampton and any inquiries may be addressed to <u>commssupport@soton.ac.uk</u>. Your data provided at entry will be matched in our relationship system with data we already hold about you to check your eligibility, conducting the prize draw, provide your prize and to carry out an analysis of which parts of our website you have engaged with to try to assess if this and other promotional tools offered by the University plays a part in your choosing to study here. Your data will not be supplied by us to a third party but our systems are supplied to us by third party providers.
