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ONGOING PAPERWORK ISSUES


Although the vast majority of the paperwork we receive is completed correctly we are still having some that are not. Please can everyone ensure that:

- Consent forms are the original top copy—with ALL relevant boxes initialled and the form is signed by the participant.
- NOT just initials and last name. We are going to need to follow up in the Cancer Registries and initials may make this difficult
- If samples are taken we need the Sample Requisition Form (SRF) returned with the consent form,. The PINK consent copy should be sent to the Human Tissue Bank with all samples; along with the Trial Request Form (TRF) for bloods. If participants initial the boxes for samples and don't give one please send the SRF with no marked for blood and saliva
- The small lilac EDTA tube must be marked with full name, dob and gender or Haematology reject them.

Study update for 2017

Recruitment will continue until at least the end of March 2017, but may be extended for a further few months if funding permits.

All co-ordination is now from Southampton so please contact us with any queries you may have.

We will not be purchasing any further saliva kits and only have a few remaining. These will be sent on a very limited basis until we run out. Patients will still be able to provide an optional blood sample and we are keen to collect as many blood samples as possible.

As per study policy, we will only supply half the number of Lifestyle Questionnaires to packs. We ask that all recruiters encourage online completion and only if the participant is unwilling to do so are they asked if they want to take a paper version. We currently do not have the capacity to upload the number of paper versions arriving in Southampton.
