The Leverhulme Trust has awarded the Southampton Marine and Maritime Institute (SMMI) 15 fully-funded PhD grants, with the second group of five scholars to commence in October 2016.

You will join a dynamic cohort of high calibre students addressing the key global issues identified and work as part of a team with world leading academics. Scholarships will be funded for 3 years and include full-time UK/EU fees.

Applications are now invited to the following projects:

- 1. Engineering analysis of 19th Century British merchant ships and shipbuilding
- 2. What are the social equity challenges for coastal flood adaptation and insurance in terms of engineering and legal issues facing private dwellings?
- 3. Micro-plastics in the environment and risks to human health
- 4. Assessing the viability of Arctic hydrate exploitation
- 5. Subsea transmission: economic and environmental limitations
- 6. Hybrid propulsion for LNG bunker vessels
- 7. New off-ship support service concepts for future maritime operations
- 8. Mapping potential wreck sites with seafloor data scientific, social and legal considerations
- 9. Spatio-temporal modelling of population and vulnerability to coastal hazards in East Asia
- 10. Understanding and addressing maritime issues through fleet analysis
