ECAT Top tip for the month: February

Say your child's name before you communicate with them.

This is important because your child might not know you are talking to them if you aren't looking at them.

Your own name is music to your ears. Our children are no different, plus it helps to get their attention before delivering your message.

For example...

"George, please go and get......". Young children can often only concentrate on one thing at a time. Call your child's name until you have their attention before you speak. Eg "Helen". (Wait until she stops kicking the ball and looks at you.) "Lunch will be ready in ten minutes".
