

Early career researcher BBSRC sequencing grant application rules:

- 1. Applicant must be early career researcher (less than 4 years post-*viva* on 7th May 2015, research students are also eligible);
- 2. Applications must be 100 words or less, plus a project title, and be sent by 30th April to bings@soton.ac.uk;
- 3. Ethical approval (if required) must be in place on application;
- 4. All funds (maximum £2,500) must be spent on nucleic acid sample preparation and the generation of next-generation sequence data (of any species);
- 5. ECR applicant must lead the project although others may be involved in the project;
- 6. Funds must be spent within one year of award;
- 7. Shortlisted entries will be required to give 2 minute presentation on 7th May prior to final decision;
- 8. Successful applicant will present work in 2016 NGS Symposium;
- 9. Decision of judges is final.
