

Promotion Process 2015/2016 – Level 4-5

In previous years it was not mandatory to collate the data centrally for our promotions from level 4 to 5, as these were managed within individual faculties. However for the 2015/2016 promotion process, it was made a mandatory requirement that the data be provided alongside the other levels.

The data collected as part of the most recent promotions round showed positive engagement in the process from those at levels 4-5, with 65 applications being received in total. There were 46 applications supported at this level, with 18 of these being promoted on the Research pathway. In addition to this, 4 applicants moved from the Research onto the balanced pathway.
