Student visas

Before you come to study in the UK it is important to find out about UK immigration procedures and how they affect you. If you are from the EU, the EEA or Switzerland, you would not normally require a visa to enter the UK

The University has its own dedicated Visa Guidance Team which can assist you with any questions you might have about applying to come to the UK as a general student or as a student visitor. Accommodation

- 15 December for semester 2 entry.

Summer School

Fee Waiver Exchange

Exchange students need to be nominated by their Home University in the first instance, and they will be invited to submit an application form and the supporting documents.
