	- Ostgradate Master S Frogrammes	The Pass Mark for the Level 7 dissertation is 60%. A candidate failing to achieve the Pass Mark may submit a revised dissertation on one occasion only. The mark for a resubmitted dissertation will be Capped at the Module Pass Mark to determine progression or the level of any exit award.
