I understand a copy of this form will be sent to my Faculty Office asking them to take all reasonable steps to inform Financial Information & Assistance if they become aware of any of the above, as well as any concerns about satisfactory academic progress.

I understand that any discrepancies between this declaration and the **Confirmation of Attendance & Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Declaration** will be investigated and no funds will be disbursed until investigations are complete.
