Daniel Drummond (MSci Geophysics, with year abroad, 2012)



Daniel joined RSK, the UK's leading engineering and environmental consultancy, as a graduate in 2012. He joined RSK's only small, but dedicated, team of five geophysicists based in Hertfordshire.

After numerous projects; taking him to the deserts of southern Iraq, via the cold tundra of Georgia, Eastern Europe, including several contaminated petrol forecourts, countless muddy

fields and the odd set of soggy site notes, he now leads RSK's newest geophysics team out of their Southampton office. He is part of a network of 38 geophysicists within the organisation. Daniel is a Chartered Geologist of the Geological Society of London and recently won an innovation award for jointly re-vamping the geophysics graduate scheme.

Francesca Trotman (MSci Marine Biology, 2015)



Francesca is the Managing Director and Founder of Love The Oceans, a marine conservation charity working in Mozambique. She holds a master's in marine biology, has always had a passion for marine life, and is an emerging leader in the ethical tourism space. She is the recipient of the 2021 Ocean Award by Blue Marine Foundation & BOAT international. Results orientated, she constantly encourages people to consider conservation in

everyday life and take a greener approach to modern living. She likes to stay close to the research and community, overseeing the majority of programs on the ground in Mozambique where Love The Oceans is working to establish a marine protected area in Jangamo, achieving higher biodiversity whilst protecting endangered species. They run community outreach projects and collect environmental data in a previously unstudied area. Love The Oceans was recognized as 1 of 15 global grassroots Forces For Change by the Duke and Duchess of Sussex, receiving international recognition for their work.

Top Tips from past panel members

Make yourself stand out. What can you do to make yourself or your application distinctive?

Take advantage of the discounted rates at university for activities like powerboat and VHF radio qualifications.

Work on your soft skills – it doesn't matter how deep your knowledge is if you can't communicate it to someone else.

Practice networking and interviewing techniques. It helps.

Confidence is key in selling yourself! Be confident in your abilities and make sure this comes across in every application form and interview you take.

Make sure you could imagine yourself in a role before you spend hours on an application.

Be picky, go for jobs that suit you and that you will enjoy. If you find one, don't hold back.

Don't underestimate the power of a good first impression.

Start planning early - internships and work experience are increasingly essential to getting a job, and that means planning to use time off over summer effectively.

Work experience is absolutely key. Talk to your tutor or Careers and Employability about the opportunities available.
