- ii. To consider and comment on existing and emerging trends, changes to policy and operational concerns raised by Union Safety Representatives or other members of staff or students.
- iii. To obtain feedback and relay comments about health and safety matters.
- iv. To meet a minimum of three times a year with minutes and recommendations of those meetings reported to the University Executive Board.
