

## Careers, Employability and Student Enterprise Year in Employment: Learning Outcomes

The Year in Employment is assessed on a Pass/Fail basis. In order to pass, the student must:

- 1. Successfully complete a minimum of 30 weeks in full-time\* work, not including annual leave.
- 2. Submit a final Reflective Report which meets the Learning Outcomes.

\*Students undertaking an unpaid placement may be eligible to work 4 days per week, leaving 1 day to seek paid, part-time work.

## **Learning Outcomes**

By the end of placement all students should be able to:

- 1. Discuss the various aspects of the industry in which they work, including the internal company structure and the wider landscape of their sector.
- 2. Describe the purpose of their role within the context of the business and the contribution it makes to the organisation as a whole.
- 3. Identify the skills, attributes and behaviours required for the sector in which they are placed.
- 4. Evaluate the development of their skills, attributes and behaviours over the course of the Year in Employment.
- 5. Identify areas for personal and career development and how these can be addressed.

## **Reflective Report**

In addition to completing a minimum of 30 weeks on placement, students must submit a final Reflective Report. The report should answer each of the Learning Outcomes detailed above.

## **Employer contribution to assessment**

Employers are not required to provide any contribution to the student's assessment during the Year in Employment.
