Check in when you arrive

The Students' Union

there are plenty of groups where you can explore creative practice or try something completely new.

You'll also have access to sports teams and societies at Highfield Campus, offering everything from casual social sport to competitive university-level teams.

Accommodation

Our accommodation offers a welcoming and supportive place to live while you study. It's designed to help you settle quickly, meet new people, and feel part of the student community.

Why live in university accommodation?

- Newly refurbished common room, laundrette, and bicycle storage
- High-speed internet in bedrooms and shared spaces
- Good-value travel links between Winchester and Southampton
- Cleaning support for communal areas
- Utilities, laundry (with detergent), and contents insurance included
- Opportunity to meet other WSA students and build a community
- Accredited by the UUK Student Accommodation Code
- Comprehensive contents insurance

You can also request a quieter flat, alcohol free flat, female-only flat, or to live with friends (for some students).

Transport

Distance from WSA to Southampton

- 🚆 Train: 20 mins
- 🚌 Bus: 50 mins

Distance from WSA to Erasmus Park accommodation

- 🚶 Walk: 15 mins
- 🚌 Bus: 10 mins
- 🚲 Bike: 5 mins

Visiting Erasmus Park Halls

Erasmus Park is about a 15-minute walk from WSA. If driving, follow the directions provided here rather than Google Maps, which directs you to the pedestrian entrance. Parking is available without a permit, head to reception and the common room for your accommodation tour.

See pages 14 – 15 for a directional map.

FROM WINCHESTER SCHOOL OF ART:

- Turn left onto Park Avenue and then turn left onto North Walls B333, keep left at the fork.
- Follow Easton Lane, drive past the pedestrian entrance and turn left onto Moorside Road.
- Follow Moorside Road around to the left and turn left when you see the Erasmus Park sign.

FROM THE M27:

- Leave the motorway at Junction 9
- At the roundabout take the Easton Lane exit towards Winnall Industrial Estate
- At the roundabout take the second exit
- Turn right onto Moorside Road
- Follow Moorside Road around to the left and turn left when you see the Erasmus Park sign.

You can park without a permit.

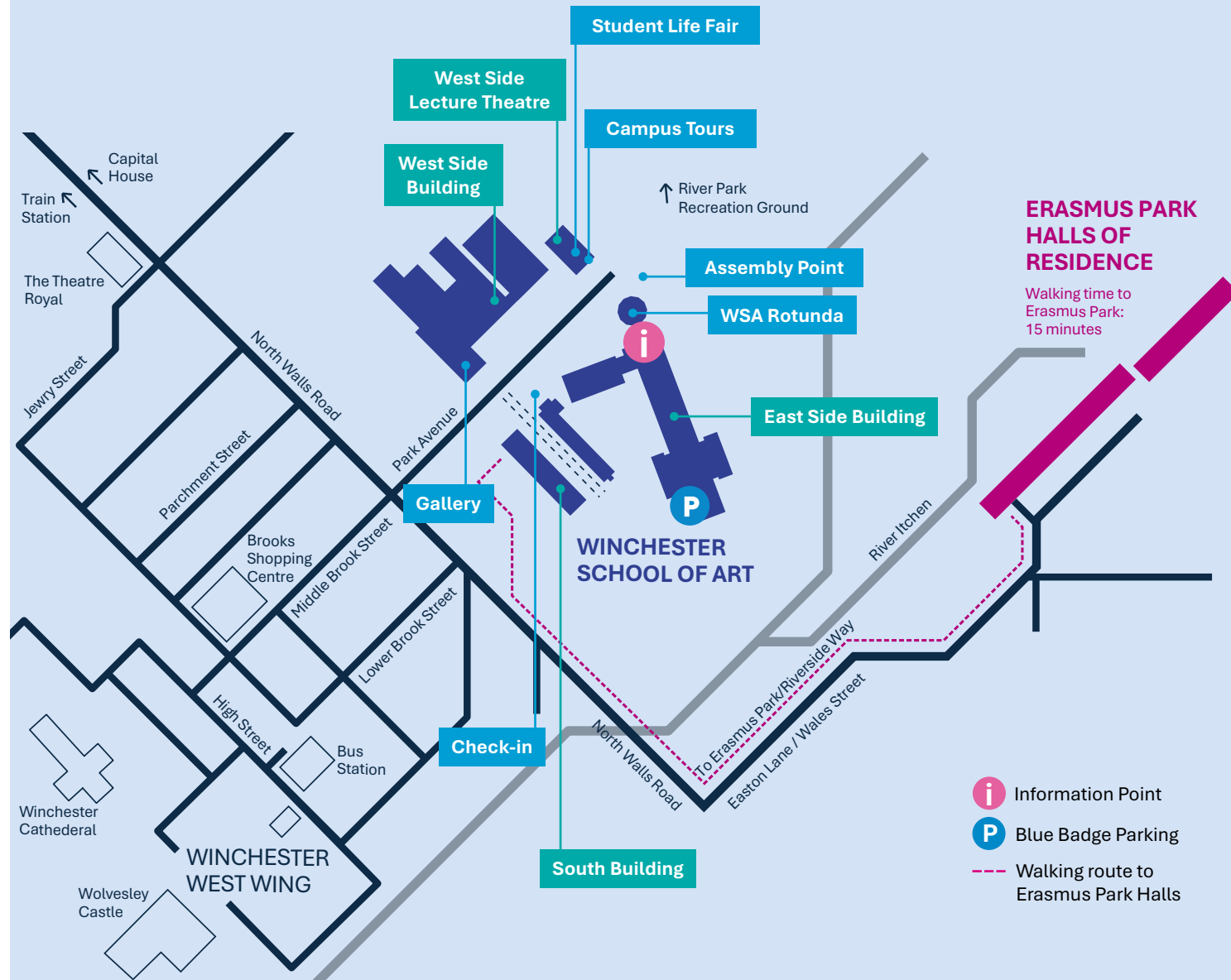
