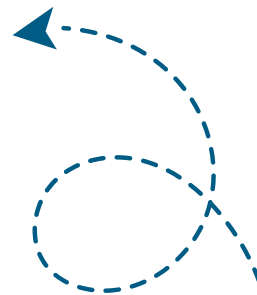


GETTING TO SOUTHAMPTON



FROM LONDON HEATHROW (60 miles, 96.5 km)

<u>TRANSPORT</u>	<u>APPROXIMATE COST</u>	<u>ROUTE</u>	<u>CONTACT/WEBSITE</u>
by Train	£45-60	Take the Heathrow Express to London Paddington then take the underground or taxi to London Waterloo station. From there, you can catch a direct train to Southampton Central Station.	Trainline National Rail
by Coach	£25	Make your way to Heathrow Central Bus Station outside terminal 2. Take the National Express service to Southampton City Centre or University.	National Express
by Taxi	£150-200	Book a long-distance taxi prior to arrival. Remember, not all taxis at ranks will travel beyond London.	Minicab Quotes

FROM LONDON GATWICK (80 miles, 129 km)

<u>TRANSPORT</u>	<u>APPROXIMATE COST</u>	<u>ROUTE</u>	<u>CONTACT/WEBSITE</u>
by Train	£20	Direct trains to Southampton Central Station are available hourly from the Gatwick rail station at the South Terminal	Trainline National Rail
by Coach	£25	Make your way to the Gatwick Coach Station in the North Terminal. Take the National Express service to Southampton City Centre or University.	National Express
by Taxi	£125-175	Book a long-distance taxi prior to arrival. Remember, not all taxis at ranks will travel beyond London.	Minicab Quotes
