- Number of places in the waiting list and how many from the waiting list were given offers - the waitlist is on going until A level results day. It is constantly changing, as the numbers on the waiting list are not static due to applicants still choosing their university choices. Therefore, the University considers this information to be not held at this time.
- The highest and lowest UCAT score for every successful applicant -2930 is the lowest score invited to interview for non-Southampton graduates. The lowest score for Southampton graduates invited to interview was 2790. Offers are made based on interview performance.

If you do not feel that we have dealt with your request in accordance with the requirements of [Part I](#) of the Act, you may request a review. Your request for a review should specify in what respect you consider that the requirements of [Part I](#) have not been met.
