We will acknowledge your request for a review and endeavour to respond within 20 working days of its receipt but please note that a deadline for a review response is not prescribed by the Act.

The Information Commissioner is responsible for enforcing rights of access to information and the operation of the publication scheme. You may apply to the Information Commissioner in writing (FOI/EIR Complaints Resolution, Information Commissioner's Office, Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire SK9 5AF) or <u>electronically</u> for a decision whether, in any specified respect, your request for information has been dealt with by the University in accordance with the requirements of <u>Part I</u> of the Act. The Information Commissioner will not normally take action unless they are satisfied that the University's review procedure has been exhausted.

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
