For the current admissions cycle 2022-23 entry, this period is still active. We will hold this data but will be publicly available from UCAS in the future. UCAS <u>future publication dates</u> are available on their website, and detailed end-of-cycle data is usually available around January.

We have considered whether the public interest in maintaining the exemption is greater than the public interest in disclosing the information and have considered <u>recommendations by the Information Commissioner's Office</u>.
