Below is your question with the University's corresponding response.

## Question

I would like to enquire about the amount of missed offers for the BM6 course.

Out of those who received offers, how many missed their offer? (if any) Were any students still offered a place despite missing their offer? If so, how many? If they can be provided, how many grades were the offers missed by?

## **Response:**

In accordance with <u>section 1(a)</u> of the Act, we confirm that the University holds information of the description specified in your request. The answers to your questions are as follows:

Whilst we hold the requested information, we are unable to provide it, as it is exempt from disclosure by virtue of <u>Section 40(2)</u> of the Act. The information requested constitutes an individual's personal data as defined under <u>Section 3 of the Data Protection Act 2018</u>. To release the information would breach the first data protection principle of the Data Protection Principles concerning f irness. To extract this data we would have to go into individual student files and re-process data.

Section 40(2) of the Act confers an absolute exemption.

If you do not feel that we have dealt with your request in accordance with the requirements of <u>Part I</u> of the Act, you may request a review. Your request for a review should specify in that respect you consider that the requirements of <u>Part I</u> have not been met.
