1. Origin

The Collaborative Provision Subcommittee is a subcommittee of the Academic Quality and Standards Committee (AQSC) set up to advise the AQSC on the regulatory and quality assurance framework in respect of collaborative provision in the UK and overseas.

2. Purpose

- To advise the AQSC on the regulatory and quality assurance framework in respect of collaborative provision in the UK and overseas, taking due account of external reference points such as the UK Quality Code for Higher Education.
- The Chair is responsible for ensuring that any equality impacts against each project/policy/process/procedure have been considered as part of the decision-making process.

3. Responsibilities and activity

- To advise the AQSC on the implementation, and the development, of policies relating to collaborative provision.
- To consider and to advise the AQSC on the level of risk associated with individual partnerships and the level of due diligence

- To consider reports from Collaboration Approval/Review Panels and to make recommendations to the AQSC.
- To monitor the University's portfolio of collaborative programmes, receiving, following consideration by School Programmes Committees, annual collaborative provision reports from Schools, and providing feedback as necessary for consideration and action by Schools
- To advise the AQSC of any action or issues in relation to standards or quality in the operation of collaborative partnerships.
- To encourage the sharing of good practice across Schools and Faculties with regard to the establishment and ongoing management of collaborative provision.

4. Reporting arrangements

The Collaborative Provision Subcommittee reports to the AQSC.

5. Constitution

It is proposed that the membership should be reviewed annually to ensure that the composition of the group reflects those Schools and Faculties which are engaging in a significant amount of collaborative provision.
