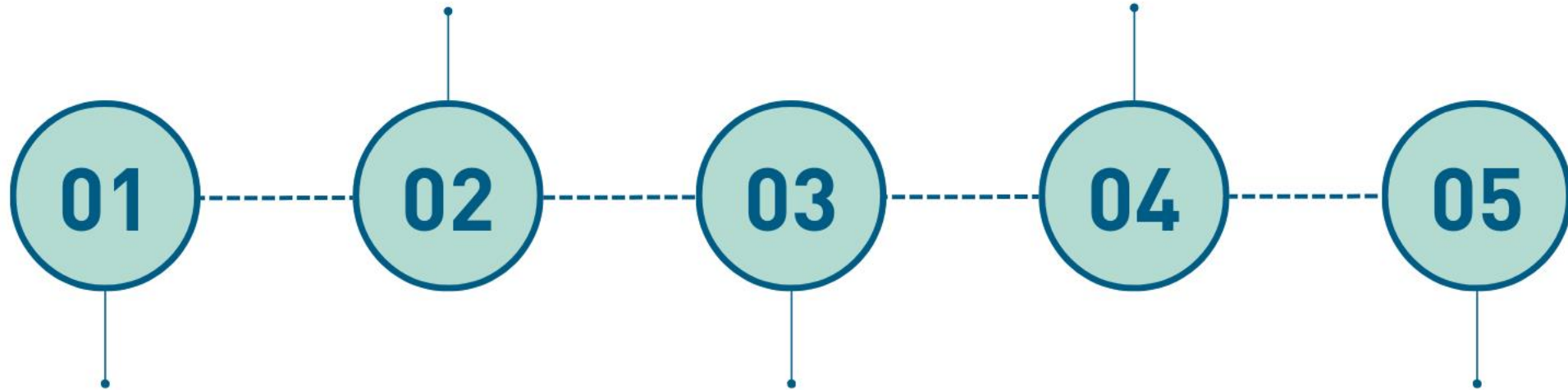

 - Technology for Employability, for the innovative creation of an AI chatbot in partnership with GTI (our CRM provider)
 - University of the Year, for the impact of SF on the university
- March 25, SF won Best Faculty Programme at the Global Careers Summit 2025 in Belfast:
 - The judges were particularly impressed by the comprehensive nature of the approach, where 98% of our programmes were mapped last year, the fact that it focuses on the increasing importance of skills in recruitment and that it links skills development to career ideas
- The AI chatbot we developed with GTI is now being sold commercially as Skillsconnect, with interest generated across the sector
