University level information

In view of COVID-19, the University has had to make changes to some elements of programme delivery for 2020-21. These changes have included the method of delivery, such as face-to-face and online, and the number of modules available.

The University aims to provide as much of a face-to-face component to your education as prevailing conditions at the time allow, combined with its new blended approach that will develop active independent and group online learning.

As the COVID-19 pandemic develops, the University's response to this and other issues may likewise need to evolve. The University will consult with student representatives as necessary and appropriate and will communicate changes to you as soon as practicable so that you have the information you need to understand how a change may impact you and what steps you need to take next. The University remains committed to supporting you as you learn.

Programme Information

In light of Covid-19, teaching and learning methods may be adapted. Lectures, seminars, tutorials, language classes including orals and consultation with academic staff may be delivered online or in person as the prevailing conditions allow. Group sizes for tutorials and seminars and language classes including orals may be adjusted to, for example, blended learning. Assessment methods may also be adapted. For example, exams may be replaced by coursework or take-home assignments and individual and group presentations and projects, including oral tasks for your language modules, may take place online or be adapted to allow for social distancing guidelines. In addition, you will be registered for a language module in Y1 and we will register you for the language that we believe you are most suited to study. If you arrive in Southampton and find that you are registered for a language that you do not wish to study, you will be able to request transfer to a different language stage up to the end of week 2 of the semester, subject to timetabling constraints. In MLL, we were already planning to make these changes (for educational reasons) for 21/22 entry, but have had to do so earlier than planned.
