In view of COVID-19, the University has had to make changes to some elements of programme delivery for 2020-21. These changes have included the method of delivery, such as face-to-face and online, and the number of modules available.

The University aims to provide as much of a face-to-face component to your education as prevailing conditions at the time allow, combined with its new blended approach that will develop active independent and group online learning.

As the COVID-19 pandemic develops, the University's response to this and other issues may likewise need to evolve. Programme Information

Group sizes for tutorials and seminars and language classes including orals may be adjusted to, for example, blended learning. Assessment methods may also be adapted. For example, exams may be replaced by coursework or take-home assignments and individual and group presentations and projects, including oral tasks for your language modules, may take place online or be adapted to allow for social distancing guidelines.
