RYA Competent Crew Part 2 (3 Days)

What to Expect

Competent Crew Part 2 is aimed at complete beginners as the last 3-days of the 5-day course, that is an introduction to yacht sailing. By the end of the course, you will have experienced steering a yacht, sail handling, ropework and be aware of safety on board. On this course you will be staying overnight in other ports. You will be sailing the yacht after sunset.

Pre-Requisites

- Must have attended the Competent Crew Part 1 before this course.
- Minimum age 12, under 16s need to be on the course with an adult.

Timings

Course normally run over long weekends i.e., Saturday, Sunday and Monday. For precise timings check your booking confirmation. On this course you will be staying overnight in other ports. Your instructor will meet you at Town Quay Marina reception at your allotted start time as stated in the booking confirmation.

What to Bring

- Water bottle
- Closed toe non-marking shoes (feet may get wet)
- Comfortable clothing for 3 days
- Sleeping bag
- Head torch with red light
- Toiletries
- Hat and gloves
- Any medications
- Money for mooring fees
