RYA Day Skipper Part 2 (3 Days)

What to Expect

RYA Day Skipper part 2 is aimed at people who have passed RYA Day Skipper part 1. This is the last 3-days of the 5-day course, that is an introduction to skippering a yacht on a passage. You will learn pilotage, navigation, seamanship and boat handling up to the standard required to skipper a small cruising yacht safety by day in waters with which you are familiar. On this course you will be staying overnight in other ports and will be a chance to practice the skills of skippering a passage. You will experience entering a port by night. After passing the RYA Day Skipper Part 2 You can apply for your International Certificate of competence.

Pre-Requisites

- 5 days at sea (Competent Crew Course)
- 100 miles (Competent Crew Course)
- 4-night hours (Competent Crew Course)
- RYA Day Skipper Theory
- Minimum age 16

Timings

Course normally run over weekends 9am - 5pm, for precise timings check your booking confirmation. This course is day sailing from Town Quay, Southampton meaning you will return on the first night at 5pm and stay at your own accommodation. Your instructor will meet you at Town Quay Marina reception at your allotted start time as stated in the booking confirmation.

- Closed toe none marking shoes (feet may get wet)
- Comfortable clothing for 3 days
- · Sleeping bag
- Toiletries

- RYA Day Skipper Theory, RYA 1st Aid and VHF/SRC assessment Certificates
