What to Expect

This is a 3-day course aims

Stage 4: A Stage 4 certificate means that you have the skills to sail a double-handed boat as crew or helm, and solve a variety of problems afloat. Passing this course is the natural entry point for the advanced courses.

Pre-Requisites

- This course is good for anyone with an interest in being out on the water.
- Ages 8 - 14.
- Participants should have previously completed youth sailing stage 3.

Timings

- Something to wear under a wetsuit (swimming costumes are good for this)
- Towel
