

## PC COM2 to Digital Test-Bed (Green)

This green cable is to get its first use in 1999 October for Part II exercise M1. It brings the PC's second serial port onto the Digital Test-Bed's 8-way connection block in the top left corner. As with all Digital Test-Bed RJ45 cables, the basis of the Digital Test-Bed end is a standard Ethernet cable. The twisted pair assignments are possibly not optimal for use with RS232, but are acceptable.

Note that in many applications only Rx/D and Tx/D are connected to Digital Test-Bed circuitry, in which case the user should link hardware handshake lines CTS/RTS and DSR/DTR. For running simple interaction with Terminal on the PC, with the default configuration of Terminal, CTS/RTS linking is essential.

The cable sheath is *green*.
